Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this letter finds you well and that you are having a good summer.

We would like to update you on our wraparound care provision and start and finish times from September.

Daily wraparound club—A light snack and drink will be provided at each session.

- 7.30am—8:45am at a cost of £5.00 per session
- 8:00am— 8:45am at a cost of £3.00 per session
- 3.15pm –4.15pm at a cost of £4.00 per session
- 3.15pm—5.30pm at a cost of £9.00 per session

Children will be collected/picked up from the main school gate by a member of staff, if for any reason your are running late, you will need to ring the school office when you arrive and a member of staff will meet you at the main gate. The sessions are bookable via ParentPay or by contacting the school office via email. Please ensure your account is credited weekly to enable your child to continue to attend.

Before Summer, we put a letter out to consult around extending the school day. Due to the limited number of responses, we will continue to keep the school day the same. This is something we may come back to in the future.

The school will reopen on Monday 6th September. At this current time, the restrictions for Covid will be lifted when the children come back to school. On a morning, the staff will be at the main gate from 8:45am—8:55am, pupils arriving after this time will be marked as late. The school day will end at 3.15pm for all pupils, the main gates will be open to enable parents to come to the crossing where it will be cordoned off to allow staff to hand over the children, EYFS and KS1 will leave from the left hand side and KS2 will leave from the right.

When the children return to school they will be able to bring a bag to school. The EYFS and KS1 children should bring a book bag book rather than a back pack, due to storage. The KS2 children can bring a back pack. The children are not permitted to bring toys etc. into school. The children do not need to bring a pencil case as all their equipment will be provided by school.

If KS2 parents want their child/ren to walk home please complete the form sent via ParentPay.

From September, we will be starting to look into OPAL play and doing more forest school. We would like to ask parents to provide wellies, that will stay in school all year, so we can do these activities at any time. If you can label the wellies and put them into bags. If you are unable to provide this, please let school know and we will provide them with a pair.

We will inform parents of PE days in the first week of September.
