

Creative

Design and Technology

This term, your child develop skills by designing and making a card with levers. They will look at a range of levers and mechanisms and create a design criteria for their card which will use one a lever of their choice.

Music

This term, we will be focusing on beat and rhythm in music. Children will be working hard to identify the pulse and rhythm as well as copying it. Your child will also be listening and critiquing a range of music. Your child will also be developing their vocal skills by singing a piece of music with two pitches.

Humanities (History, Geography)

History

Your child will be developing their chronological awareness by placing significant events and people on a timeline. They will look at he changes that have occurred in the Monarchy and comparing Queen Victoria to Queen Elizabeth II.

RSHE

Your child will be learning about relationships this half term. They will be focusing on themselves, learning about what makes them special. They will also learn about what parts of themselves they should keep private and what to do if they need to tell someone about these issues.

Science

This term your child will be learning about living things including humans. They will be learning about different animals and their characteristics. Important vocabulary that your child will learn includes; carnivore, herbivore, omnivore, invertebrate and vertebrate.

RE

This term, your child will be focusing on the question, 'Who created the World?' They will learn that Christians believe that God created the world in seven days. We will also be looking at the Christian festival, Harvest, and it's importance to Christians.

Autumn 1

PE

In PE, your child will be developing their physical skills by playing Ten Point Hoop. Children will be developing their throwing technique and control as well as their aim. They will continuing to work on their hand eye coordination, throwing and catching in games scenarios.

Books/resources/films/music/visits/visitors/role play etc

This term, we will be reading a range of literature linking to out other topics on genres of writing. We will be creating our own stories and sharing them in National Storytelling Week.

Computing

This term, your child will be improving their mouse skills and digital literacy by beginning to use Microsoft packages and safely searching using the internet. Children will also look at the influence technology has on our day to day lives and what impact the internet has on us. Children will also continue to develop their online safety knowledge.

English

This term, your child will be looking to improve their punctuation and sentence structure. We will explore a range of different sentence types. We will be looking at a range of text types, including fairy tales, poems and descriptions.

Basic Skills

Your child will be exploring simple sentences and the basic punctuation used when punctuating sentences. They will look at extending their sentences using 'and'.

Reading

Children will begin to discuss books read by the teacher answering a range of retrieval, inference, prediction and sequencing questions.

Maths

Mental

We will be developing fluency in counting forwards and backwards from zero and any given number.

Main

This term, your child will be working on developing their place value skills which will be used to solve addition and subtraction problems. Your child will be using a range of concrete objects and visual representations to support them.
