The posts are to support children from all age groups, from Reception to Year 6, but are likely to be focussed in one phase of the school.

Tutors will be required to work with the support of the Senior Leadership Team and class teachers. Working either 1 to 1, or a maximum of 1 to 3 pupils at a time, on maths and English objectives.

They will be required to identify gaps in pupils' learning and work closely with the children to help close the gaps.

Suitable candidates include teaching and learning staff such as teachers, teaching assistants and ITT trainees.

Staff without Qualified Teacher Status must pass an online training course, this includes teaching assistants (or those with similar teaching support roles) and ITT Trainees.
