 Introduced last year to check knowledge of multiplication facts.

Was not compulsory last year.

Will take place in June.













Purpose

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help your child's school to identify if your child may need additional support.











What is the multiplication test?

- On Screen test
- Consists of 25 random questions
- 6 seconds for each question.
- Test will last 5 minutes













Results

- Will be used by the school to help target additional support.
- Results will be reported back to parents as with all national curriculum tests.
